- The management undertakes to act in cases of emergencies according to the legal conditions of the Institutions.
- This requires collaboration and participation at all levels and for this, information, communication and training are essential.
- All staff must accept the commitment to improve quality, production methods and safe work to prevent injuries and deterioration of health and good environmental practices within the field of their job

The General Management, through the Training Plan, ensures that its integrated Policy is understood and accepted by all staff, through internal audits it verifies that the System maintains its efficiency and adequacy and with the periodic Review by the Management it verifies that this Policy is kept updated and in force.
